INDEPENDENT LIVING SKILLS, ADAPTIVE EQUIPMENT/ASSISTIVE TECHNOLOGY, COMMUNICATION SKILLS, ORIENTATION AND MOBILITY TRAINING, SELF-ADVOCACY, ADJUSTMENT COUNSELING, TRANSPORTATION RESOURCES, AND PEER SUPPORT. ELIGIBLE INDIVIDUALS CANNOT BE SEEKING EMPLOYMENT, JOB RETENTION, OR DEPARTMENT OF REHABILITATION CONSUMERS.

ELIGIBILITY:

18-54 YEARS OF AGE

NOT EMPLOYED OR SEEKING JOB RETENTION

NOT A PART OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REHABILITATION (DOR)

INDEPENDENT LIVING PHILOSOPHY

THE INDEPENDENT LIVING SERVICE MODEL REQUIRES FULL PARTICIPATION FROM THE CONSUMER, OR DESIGNATED REPRESENTATIVE, IN FORMING SERVICE AND GOAL ATTAINMENT PLANS.
